24th October - 4th November - Half Term

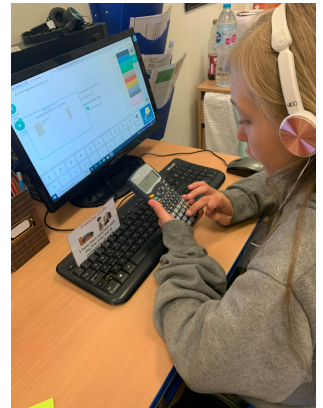
Pre-Loved Uniform

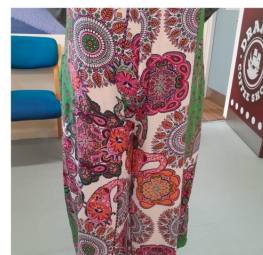
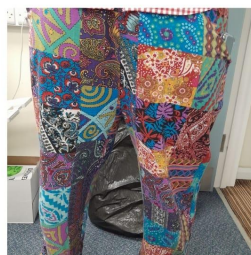
The end of Pride month culminated in a Pride Parade in school. This event was well attended by both staff and pupils - there was lots of dancing, singing and most of all **S M I L E S**
